Procedures for International Press Coverage Angola General Elections 2017

WHO: Members of Foreign Press

All members of Foreign Press interested to cover the 2017 Angola General Elections, to be held in August 23, 2017, must communicate their intention in writing to the National Electoral Commission, not later than 20 days before the voting day.

PROCEDURES:

1-

To obtain entry visas in the Republic of Angola, all members of the foreign press must go to the Angola General Consulates to the United States (New York, Houston and Los Angeles) or to the Consular Section of the Embassy of Angola to the US, located at the 2100 16TH Street NW to submit their visa application;

2-

The process must include the form available on the website of the Angola National Press Center Aníbal de Melo (CIAM), for press coverage of the Angola 2017 General Elections filled;

3-

For the issuance of the credential, the journalist or member of the press must pay the amount in Kwanzas (Angolan national currency), corresponding to \$100 US dollars, subject to readjustment whenever there are exchange rate changes;

4-

ACCREDITATION:

Provisional accreditation of members of the foreign press or other member of the social communication is considered a personal act and takes place as soon as He (She) shows up at CIAM soon after the arrival in Angola.
